Obligations under the Qld Electrical Safety Act and Regulations

- Complying with company instructions and ensuring that all electrical work completed is safe;

- Not wilfully interfering or misusing anything that may create an unsafe situation for themselves or others.

All team members must adopt a "test before touch" approach and treat all conductors and equipment as live until proven otherwise.

All electrical incidents or dangerous events will be reported and investigated in accordance with the CV Services Incident Reporting and Investigation Procedure.
